- Christians to commit to becoming Disciple-Makers
- More Christians to be mobilized for prayer
- That God will draw the unbelieving to Himself. That they will want to explore Jesus through DBS
- Believers intentionally engaging unbelievers
- For opportunities for Casual-Meaningful-Spiritual conversations with unbelievers
- Boldness for inviting unbelievers to form or join Discovery Bible Studies
- Protection from Satan's attacks
- God's Kingdom Come

- Help us see opportunities for developing relationships with the lost
- Help us see the needs and brokenness around us
- How do we seek justice and do mercy within our city?
- What corruption and injustice do we need to address, and how?
- How can we make peace within our city?

- Protection, provision, and volunteers for those already working within our city. How can we help them?
- Praying for those in authority:
 - That authority figures will know Christ and have the courage, integrity, and wisdom to lead righteously
 - Pray against known corruption.
 - Help us raise us godly, capable leaders
 - That our police and other judicial authorities will be just, fair, and righteous in all their dealings
 - That our godly leaders, police, emergency personnel, and judicial authorities will have the protection and support they need and success in establishing righteousness

Prayer that grows exponentially to prepare the way for a Disciple-Making, Gospel Movement in your community & city

→ Why should we pray

For God to start a disciple making movement of great commission and great commandment work where the gospel transforms every community and aspect of society and culture in your city

→ With whom should we pray

Meet with 1-5 of your friends

→ When should we pray

Once a week. Pick a time and place that is natural. Something that already fits within your schedule or paired with another activity.

→ Where should we pray

Meet wherever is convenient. Your house, at work, at school, at a park, before or after church or small group.

→ Special suggestions

Pair the time with a group project, hobby, or activity. Examples: walking around a park, after playing a sport, after volunteering at a soup kitchen, while children are having a play time, while waiting for kids extracurricular activities, after eating a meal together

→ How should we pray

1. Open in prayer asking for God to speak to the group:
 - What should we be praying for?
 - What are the needs and brokenness in our city?
 - Where and how are you working already in the city?
 - What do you want us to do about it? And how?
2. Listen to God (7 minutes approx.)
3. Popcorn prayer- start praying for the things that God has placed on your hearts. No one prays for more than a couple of minutes at a time.
4. Ask for 1-2 prayer requests from each of the group. Each member prays for one other member out loud.
